**NOTICE OF VACANT POSITION ON
BOARD OF COMMISSONERS OF COAL CREEK UTILITY DISTRICT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to RCW 42.12.080 that there is a vacancy on the Board of Commissioners of Coal Creek Utility District due to the resignation of a commissioner.

The District's Board of Commissioners has nominated two persons for the vacant position: Kim Lane and John Dulcich. The District is actively seeking additional qualified candidates for consideration for the vacant position, and invites all registered voters who reside in the District to submit nominations for the position. Nominations must be received by the District, at Attn: General Manager, 6801 132nd Pl. SE, Newcastle WA 98059 or customerservice@ccud.org by no later than 5:00 p.m. on **August 9, 2024**.

The District is a water-sewer district operating under Title 57 RCW. The District provides water and sewer service within a 5.7 square mile service area, generally bounded on the north by the City of Bellevue city limits (SE 69th Street), on the south by the City of Renton and City of Newcastle city limits, on the west by Lake Washington, and on the east by Cougar Mountain Regional Wildland Park. The District is governed by a three-member Board of Commissioners, which meets on the second and fourth Wednesday of each month at 2:00 p.m. The appointed person will serve from the date of appointment and qualification, until a candidate is elected for the position at the election in the Fall of 2025.

All persons nominated by either the Board of Commissioners or by the public are requested to submit an application for appointment to the vacant position. The application consists of (1) an Application Form; (2) a cover letter indicating interest and general qualifications for the position; (3) a resume; and (4) completed answers to Supplemental Questions. The complete application must be received by the District by **5:00 p.m. on August 9, 2024**. Following the application deadline, the Board of Commissioners may conduct interviews of one or more nominees and shall appoint a qualified person to the position from the candidates nominated by either the Board or the public at a Board of Commissioners' meeting. The Board anticipates making the appointment by October 3, 2024.
